

Privacy statement Katje Welding

On May 25, 2018, the new European privacy regulation called The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) came into effect. According the EU GDPR (article 6) processing shall be lawful only if and to the extent that at least one of the following applies:

The data subject has given consent to the processing of his or her personal data for one or more specific purposes.

Processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation.

In this particular case information will be processed in order to perform a contract, in which the purchaser acts as a 'recipient'. In order to facilitate the purchase of goods or (associated) services (personal), information may be collected and processed for;

- promoting goods and services;
- promoting goods and services by mail;
- product delivery;
- invoicing and billing;
- promoting goods and services by mail.

An overview of the specific (personal) information collected;

- Company's name, (visiting) address
- Contact person
- Telephone number
- E-mail address
- Bank account number
- Payment conditions/behaviour
- Terms of delivery
- Purchase history
- Company business information

The information listed provide the administrative and logistical support necessary carrying out of the contract, in particular payment processing, the supply of goods and services, website administration and (technical) IT support.

Processing of sensitive (personal) information revealing racial or ethnic origin, religious beliefs, health and data concerning a natural person's sexual orientation shall be prohibited. Information is solely collected and processed for market research purposes and analysis to support continual improvements to the products and services involved.

Cookies

A cookie is simply a piece of text which can be placed on the browser of a personal computer or mobile device. They remain on the browser while logged on to a particular website and then disappears when the browser is closed. Cookies help make our website more user-friendly and efficient. Furthermore cookies enables to conduct analyses of user traffic to measure the use of the website and to improve the content of our website and our services. These statistic analyses will be performed through the use of IP addresses and cookies.

Data subject rights

The data subject - the identifiable natural person - related to the process of the enquiry, delivery and payment of goods, shall have the right to obtain personal data concerning him or her. Furthermore, the data subject shall have the right to request rectification or erasure of personal data unless prohibited such as the obligation under criminal law.

Any correction, amendment, and/or deletion of (personal) data should be requested by e-mailing info@katjewelding.nl

At all time all data subjects shall have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority, for example 'Autoriteit Persoonsgegevens'.

Authorized Third Party Services

Katje Welding provides services towards third parties. However, the use of (personal) data is governed by the privacy policies of such parties - and in accordance with applicable data protection laws - and is not subject to our control and should be processed only if the purpose of the processing could not reasonably be fulfilled by other means. Access to this data is strictly limited and will not be shared by other services.

Financial data shall not be published, neither disclose related financial data to third parties, except contractual data involving (payment) enquiries related to the delivery and payment of ordered goods.

Any transfer of (personal) data information is secured and/or encrypted for its protection inside the European Economic Area (EEA) which are compliant with privacy and data protection laws.

Storage of (personal) data

Katje Welding ensures that (personal) data are no longer kept than necessary. Access to (personal) data is restricted only to those staff members that have clearance. Time limits have been established for erasure or for a periodic review.

Security of (personal) data

Katje Welding ensures appropriate technical and organisational measures to safeguard (personal) data information. This also includes preventing unauthorised access to (personal) data and the equipment used for the data storage and processing. Files are password protected, and data which is not required to keep pursuant to any applicable law, will be deleted by secure means.

Written contracts between Katje Welding and its (sub) processors are a general requirement. It starts by understanding the organisational risks and the resultant requirements to mitigate those risks. But it also covers topics such as how to avoid disaster and mitigate damage when dealing with a security breach.
